



## Woodturning Wigstand Challenge

May 2025

### **Objectives and Purpose**

- Promote woodturners' engagement with a Good Cause
- Contribute wig stands to cancer patients at local hospital
- Demonstrate the Guild's charitable role in the community

### **How To Participate**

- Attend the wig stand turning demonstration (Feb 2025 meeting)
- Obtain raw materials from the Guild (\$5.00 per kit for up to 2 kits at March 2025 meeting) or use your own materials
- Use the resources on TWG website or handouts from demonstration to turn as many wig stands as desired
- Ensure your wig stand conforms to the specified parameters (Mushroom diameter 3'-5", Base diameter 5"-6", Assembled Height 13"-18").
- Bring your completed wig stands to the Guild meeting (May 6, 2025) and set them on the competition table
- Obtain a voting stub and place in the cup beside the wig stand you consider most worthy of recognition and await the results of judging.
- Leave your completed wig stands with the Guild so that they can be donated to our deserving Cancer Patients.

### **Categories**

- All wig stands will be in one category.

### **General Rules**

- You must be a TWG member in good standing to enter and vote.
- You may submit as many entries as you wish.
- Members may but are encouraged not to vote for their own entries.
- TWG organizers will interpret and apply showcase rules. Their decisions are final.

### **Awards**

- One "Popular Choice" award will be given to the stand receiving the most votes
- One "Honorable Mention" award will be given to the most creative stand as chosen by a judge appointed by the competition organizers.
